CODE OF CONDUCT

- The following conduct are prohibited
- (a) Propagation of immoral ideas contrary to the social norms of the school.
- (b) Swearing and use of profane language.
- (c) Cheating in the tests and in the examinations.
- (d) Wearing jewellery such as bracelet, rings, necklaces, earring, medals and other objectionable items.
- (e) Leaving campus without proper authorization.
- (f) Bullying and bringing persons from outside into the school campus and into the hostel without permission from the principal.
- (g) Use of alcoholic beverages, tobbacco, drugs or narcotics in any form.
- (h) Damaging the school property and the hostel property.
- (i) Writing, scribbling, splashing ink or color on the walls in the school building and in the hostel.
- 2. Students are expected to handle carefully the chairs, tables, library books, lab equipments etc. If any student damages the school property He/She is liable to pay fine.
- 3. Girls are not allowed to wear sleeveless and low necked blouses and dresses.
- 4. Boys are not allowed to keep long hair covering the ears and the collar of the shirt.

PROMOTION CRITERIA & RULES

Promotion is based on the whole years performance, which includes the unit tests, half yearly and the final examination. To be eligible for promotion the following criteria must be met:

*Pass % - English 40% & other subject - 35%

(Must not have less than 75% of class attendance)

Absent in the examination means failed, no special examinations will be conducted. Absence due to sickness must be met with valid medical certificate.

The results will be declared at the end of the school year which is final. Request for reconsideration of the result will not be entertained after the result is declared.

LEAVE RULES

A student must be present on the date before and after vacation. Delay of such shall be charged with fine of Rs. 100/- per day

A student may avail of leave only on genuine reasons, being granted in advance by the Principal on the ground of written application of leave from the parent/guardian.

Prolonged absence of student due to illness must be reported in writing by the parent along with the photo copy of authentic medical certificate.

RULES FOR DAY-SCHOLARS

- 1. All day scholars must come to school on time.
- 2. Must come to the school in clean and proper uniform.
- 3. Absence from the school due to valid reason such as sickness must be supported by a valid medical certificate.
- 4. Homework and preparation for the tests must be supervised by the parent / guardian.
- 5. Bus facility is provided for the day scholars. It is the responsibility of the parent / guardian

- bring their wards to the assigned bus stop to board the school bus and be present at the same place to receive their ward from the school bus after the school is over.
- 6. All the small children should be accompanied by their parents to the school bus and must be received by the parent / guardian after the school is over.
- 7. Day-scholars are strictly prohibited to leave the school campus without the permission during the school hours.


CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION

Admission to **Chanakiya Public School** is open to all who meet the requirements of the school. Guardians seeking admission of their ward from Nursery to Std. V can avail the prospectus and admission form from the first week of January to 15th of February from the School Office.

Admission will be granted as availability of seats.

Fees once paid to the school is non refundable.

ACADEMIC SESSION

The academic session of the school is from April to March. It consists of three terms.:

First Term : April to July

Mid Term : August to November

Final Term : December to March



RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Parent / Guardian are not allowed to meet the Parents or teachers while the class is in session without the permission of the Principal.
- 2. By scholar are expected to leave the premises immediately after the school hours.
- 3. Students should not buy eatables from the wayside vendors.
- 4. Pupils are not permitted to leave the school premises without the Principal / Headmaster's permission.
- 5. No Parent / Guardian are permitted to enter into any agreement for private tuition for their wards with any teacher of the school without prior sanction from the Principal.
- 6. The school is not responsible for any students who runs away from the school at his/her own accord.
- 7. Irregularity, idleness, negligence of homework, repeated disobedience, disrespect of school staff, immoral conduct, habitual violation of the school rules, taking part in any demonstration against the order of the Government and joining any political group or undesirable movement in the school campus are offences, liable for suspension or even dismissal from the school.
- 8. Silence should be maintained throughout the school hours, especially during the change of periods.
- 9. Student must come to school in a proper time otherwise they will not be allowed to enter into the school.
- 10. Students without proper school uniform will not be allowed to enter the class.



- 11. Parents/Guardian seeking information about the school or for any suggestions must contact the Principal directly.
- 12. Parents / Guardians are not allowed to meet the students or teacher during class time without the permission of the Principal.
- 13. The change in the address of Parent / Guardian must be intimated to the school in writing without delay, failure to do so the school will not be responsible for the non-receipt of communication.
- 14. Parents / Guardian should check students daily home work assignment diary and sign in the space provided.
- 15. Progress reports are issued after each examination. Parents / Guardian are expected to check them carefully, taking note of the remarks made by the class teacher. Parents / Guardian should put initial in the progress report on the space provided and must bring it back to the school within two weeks, failure to do so, will be subjected to a penalty of Rs. 100/-.
- 16. Sick children must not be sent to attend Test / Classes.
